### Fall Turkey Cookies



#### Ingredients:

- 1 roll (16.5 oz) Pillsbury™ refrigerated sugar cookies or 1 package (16 oz) Pillsbury™ Ready To Bake!™ refrigerated sugar cookies (24 cookies)
- 1 container (16 oz) chocolate creamy frosting
- Candy corn
- Orange decorating icing
- Miniature candy-coated chocolate baking bits

#### Steps:

1. Bake cookies as directed on roll or package. Cool completely, about 10 minutes.
2. Spoon chocolate frosting into 1-quart Ziploc® Brand storage bag; seal bag. Cut off tiny bottom corner of bag. On each cookie, pipe frosting on outer edge of half of cookie. Arrange candy corn over frosting for feathers.
3. Pipe orange icing onto each cookie to resemble turkey face and feet. Use orange icing to attach baking bits to turkey face for eyes. Pipe black gel on baking bits for centers of eyes.

20 Minute prep time. 60 minute total time.

# Paper Plate Owls

- Paper plates
- Paint (may be washable if needed)
- White foam circles or white circles cut from paper (for eyes)
- Small black buttons
- Foam or construction paper (for claws and beaks)
- Fabric Scraps (in contrasting colors) cut into 2 sets of "wings", one large set and one smaller set.



## MAKING PAPER PLATE OWLS:

Set out a variety of Crayola paints. Several techniques can be used to apply the paint. You may consider a sponge, wadded up cloth, paint brush or something with an original texture.

When the paint is dry (a hair dryer may help!) Choose the appropriate glue needed: glue stick, glue bottles or brush on type.

For each wing, cut two sizes of contrasting fabric swatches. A pointy oval that follows the curve of the paper plate works well. First, glue on the wings in layers.

Once the wings are where you want them, add on white foam pieces for eyes, and black buttons in center to finish eyes.

For the final touch add feet by using a star flower type of shape. Cut them in half and they are great for feet. Cut a triangle to place for a beak!

To finish, tape a loop of yarn to the top/back of the owl so it may be hung up and displayed as a festive fall decoration.

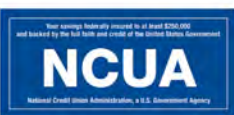
